

Semblanza

Alejandro Almanza Pereda crea esculturas, fotografía, video, arte público e instalaciones artísticas que enfatizan nuestros vínculos afectivos con los objetos, a través de obras que pueden parecer inestables, inmateriales o al borde del desastre. Sus estructuras parecen subvertir no sólo jerarquías arquitectónicas y decorativas, sino emocionales y culturales, involucrando a menudo las expectativas y el sentido común del espectador. Ha presentado exposiciones individuales en el Museo Experimental El Eco, Ciudad de México; San Francisco Art Institute (SFAI); Fundación Magnolia / Rove Gallery, Londres; y Art in General, Nueva York. Su obra es parte de las colecciones del ASU Art Museum, Arizona; Goetz Collection, Munich; El Museo del Barrio, Nueva York; KADIST, San Francisco y París; Colección Jumex, Ciudad de México; y el Museo de Arte de Lima. Ha recibido becas de la Harpo Foundation y la Fundación de Arte Cisneros Fontanals. Es miembro del proyecto musical La Rubia te Besa.

Statement

Alejandro Almanza Pereda creates sculptures, photography, video, public art, and art installations that emphasize our affective bonds with objects through works that may appear unstable, immaterial, or on the cusp of disaster. Their structures seem to subvert not only architectural and decorative hierarchies, but also emotional and cultural ones, often involving the expectations and common sense of the viewer. He has had solo exhibitions at El Eco Experimental Museum, Mexico City; San Francisco Art Institute (SFAI); Fundación Magnolia, London; and Art in General, New York. His work is part of the collections of the ASU Art Museum, Arizona; Goetz Collection, Munich; El Museo del Barrio, New York; KADIST, San Francisco and Paris; Colección Jumex, Mexico City; and the Museo de Arte de Lima. He has received grants from the Harpo Foundation and the Cisneros Fontanals Art Foundation. He is a member of La Rubia te Besa, an art band project.

Semblanza

Durante los últimos años, Claudia Peña Salinas ha desarrollado un significativo cuerpo de obra compuesto por escultura, instalación, pintura, video, publicaciones y fotografía. Después de una residencia en SOMA México, la artista se ha reencontrado con su país natal, hallando en su territorio un campo fértil y extenso para su trabajo. El proceso de documentación, viaje, recolección, acumulación y hallazgo en la práctica artística de Claudia apunta hacia una reflexión espacial, material y temporal; es una manera íntima y personal de relacionarse con México que alcanza dimensiones culturales y políticas.

Nacida en Montemorelos, Nuevo León, vive y trabaja entre Brooklyn y la Ciudad de México. Estudió en el Art Institute of Chicago y obtuvo su MFA del Hunter College en Nueva York. Ha exhibido en el Whitney Museum of American Art (2018); Museo de Arte Carrillo Gil (2015); Queens Museum of Art (2012); Museo de Arte de Puerto Rico (2006); y El Museo del Barrio (2005) en Nueva York.

Statement

In the last years, Claudia Peña Salinas has developed a significant body of work composed of sculpture, installation, painting, video, publications and photography. After a residency at SOMA México, the artist has been reunited with her native country, finding in its territory a fertile and extensive ground for her work. The process of documentation, travel, collection, accumulation and discovery in the artistic practice of Claudia points towards a spatial, material and temporal reflection; it is an intimate and personal way of relating to Mexico, which reaches cultural and political dimensions.

Born in Montemorelos, Nuevo León, she currently lives and works between Brooklyn and Mexico City. She studied at the Art Institute of Chicago and obtained her MFA from Hunter College, New York. Her work was exhibited at the Whitney Museum of American Art (2018); Museo de Arte Carrillo Gil (2015); Queens Museum of Art (2012); Museo de Arte de Puerto Rico (2006); and El Museo del Barrio (2005) in New York.

Semblanza

Juan Capistrán trabaja con escultura, pintura, video, fotografía, dibujo, instalación, performance y sonido —cuálquiera que sea el método que mejor se adapte al proyecto específico. Nacido en México y criado en un barrio predominantemente afroamericano de Los Ángeles, Capistrán conjuga hábilmente temas que van desde movimientos por los derechos civiles, pasando por la música punk, hasta el arte de los años sesenta, mezclando prácticas, referencias y temas en críticas subversivas de la cultura estadounidense.

Obtuvo un BFA de Otis College of Art and Design en 1999 y un MFA de la Universidad de California en Irvine en 2002. Su obra ha sido expuesta a nivel nacional e internacional, incluyendo el Bronx Museum, Hammer Museum, Los Angeles County Museum of Art, Museum of Contemporary Art Denver, Museo Rufino Tamayo en la Ciudad de México, y la 12a Bienal de Estambul, la Trienal Internacional Front International, entre muchos otros.

Statement

Juan Capistrán works in sculpture, painting, video, photography, drawing, installation, performance, and sound—whichever method best serves the specific project. A Mexican-born artist who grew up in a predominantly African American neighborhood in Los Angeles, Capistrán deftly maneuvers between subjects ranging from the civil rights movement to punk music to the art of the 1960s, blending practices, references and themes into subversive critiques of American culture. He earned a BFA from Otis College of Art and Design in 1999 and an MFA from the University of California at Irvine in 2002. His work has been exhibited nationally and internationally, including at the Bronx Museum, Hammer Museum, Los Angeles County Museum of Art, Museum of Contemporary Art Denver, Museo Rufino Tamayo in Mexico City, and 12th Istanbul Biennial, the Front International Triennial, among many others.
